  - Carter's KIDCYCLE™ clothing takeback program relaunched (in 2025) in select stores to help customers responsibly recycle outgrown clothing.
- **Planet: Reducing Our Footprint**
  - Over 60% of product packaging is now made from recycled content, reducing our virgin plastic use.
  - Named an EPA *Green Power Partner* for the second consecutive year, in recognition of our effort towards renewable energy development in the U.S.
- **People: Investing in Families and Communities**
  - Nearly \$35 million invested since 2021 through Carter's corporate philanthropy programs, supporting families and children nationwide.
  - Through our partnership with the Planet Water Foundation, sponsored three water filtration projects across India and Vietnam, enabling clean water access to more than 5,000 children and community members.
